Maine Medical Center is a 606 bed Level I Trauma center. It is the largest hospital in Northern New England and serves as a regional referral center for the State of Maine in addition to parts of New Hampshire and Massachusetts. Maine Medical Center is also a teaching hospital in conjunction with Tufts University Medical School.

Students provide pastoral care on units throughout the hospital. The summer CPE program typically includes five community placement sites where students also provide pastoral care, one or two per site. Description of Setting and Student Assignment Sites:

The Chaplaincy Center was founded in 1974 by the religious, medical and academic communities to serve the people of the Southern New England Area. The Chaplaincy Center is located on the Rhode Island Hospital campus. Students in the various CPE programs offered by The Chaplaincy Center have the opportunity to serve at a wide variety of clinical placements. These include two general hospitals, one of which is a level one trauma center, a pediatric hospital, a regional center hospital for the care of high risk newborns, a psychiatric hospital, a forensic psychiatric hospital, a hospice program, a rehabilitation center and an eldercare facility.
