

Eastern Region Updates:

The Administrative Board has decided to make funds available to Eastern Region members attending the ACPE Conference in Hawaii.

These funds are for: 1) regional members who are required to attend the conference for ACPE business; 2) for persons whose institutions are not reimbursing a significant portion of their expenses. Eastern Region members in the following categories are welcome to apply: retired supervisors, clinical members, supervisory candidates, CPE and Associate Supervisors. Our intention is to offer these funds to assist those who experience the cost of attending this conference as a financial hardship.

The amount of the assistance will depend on the number of requests submitted. If you are in need of a regional subsidy please send your request to the Regional Office through email, fax or snail mail. It must be received no later than September 28th. In order to receive the reimbursement subsidy, documentation will be required after the travel for tax audit purposes.

Your request need only include the category under which your are applying (e.g. required to go for ACPE business or lack of institutional support). All requests will be kept confidential.
