From New York City:

Cross George Washington Bridge (upper level), take
PALISADES PARKWAY NORTH to Exit 15

From the North:

Take New York State Thruway (I-87) South to Exit 16 (Harriman); go EAST
on Route 6 to PALISADES PARKWAY SOUTH to exit 15

From the South:

Take the New Jersey Turnpike (I-95) North to PALISADES PARKWAY
NORTH to Exit 15

From the West:

Take I-80 East to I-287 onto New York State Thruway (I-87) toward Tappan
Zee Bridge, Take Exit 13N onto PALISADES PARKWAY NORTH to Exit
15

From PALISADES PARKWAY EXIT 15

Follow arrow for Stony Point; drive 2 miles on Route 210
(also called RC 106 East) to the traffic light at the
intersection of 9W. Turn **LEFT** onto 9W; drive over bridge
to first traffic light; turn **LEFT** at the light; drive 4 blocks to
Crickettown Road. Turn **RIGHT** onto Crickettown Road;
drive about 200 yards.

Entrance to Stony Point Center is on the **LEFT**
